



**ELMWOOD HALL**

Thomas D. and Sally Carvel built this classical villa from 1818-20, facing the Ohio River on a 968-acre farm. In 1827, Wm. Barbeck of London purchased the site and named it "Hyrcia" in honor of his father, Hyrcia. In 1831-36, Israel Ludlow, Jr. and his wife Helen Adela bought the farm and developed the town of Ludlow.
