York in other sections, which are all causes of great vexation and loss, together with the injurious effects of exposure of the roots out of the ground for weeks, the danger of freezing and other unfavorable influences consequent upon a voyage from the North or East, are considerations, if there were no others, sufficient to induce Kentuckians to give the preference to Kentucky grown trees.
