and Testament, revoking all others. First of all, I

the balance, to wit: all my property, both real and
personal, with which it hath pleased God to bless
me, - also, my goods, chattels &c. of every description, I
give and bequeath to Narcissa, a mulatto girl,
which I have raised, provided that her master
or mistress, owner or proprietor, will let her go at
a moderate price. If not, I will and bequeath
all the property aforesaid, to Austin G. Hubbard,
who, (from the last account I received) is in the State
of Tennessee, Winchester County. In testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
my seal this twenty-fifth day of May, one thousand
eight hundred and twenty-three.
