This deed of conveyance this day made and entered into by and between E. S. Forett as special Commissioner of the Clark County Court of its first part and Mary T. Moore wife of John W. Moore of the second part witnesses that whereas in the proceedings of L. H. Jones et al against Frank Jones et al pending in said Court Commissioners were appointed to divide and allot among the devisees the land belonging to the late Fauntleroy Jones Dec<sup>d</sup> and mentioned in his last will and testament, and whereas said Commissioners filed their report of such allotment on April 25-1900 and said report and allotment have been approved and confirmed, and the said E. S. Forett was appointed a special Commissioner of this Court and directed to execute Deeds conveying the land so allotted to the individuals to whom each part was respectively allotted
